Author's responsibility

The Matica Srpska Journal for Slavic Studies publishes original scientific papers on Slavic languages, literatures and cultures. The Matica Srpska Journal for Slavic Studies also publishes articles and treatises, contributions and materials, scientific criticism, reviews, chronicles and bibliographies. The papers that have already been published elsewhere or have been sent to another publication cannot be published in the Matica Srpska Journal for Slavic Studies. If the paper was presented at a scientific conference, the information regarding that should be included in the footnote on the first page of the article. The authors guarantee that the manuscript represents their original contribution, that it has not been published before and is not being considered for publication elsewhere. At the same time, submitting manuscripts to multiple journals is a violation of ethical standards. Such a manuscript is instantly excluded from further consideration. The authors also guarantee that after the publication in the journal Matica Srpska Journal for Slavic Studies, the manuscript will not be published elsewhere in any language without the consent of the Editorial Board. In case that a manuscript is a result of research project or that, in the previous version, it was presented in the form of an oral presentation, detailed information about the project, the conference and the like are cited in a footnote at the beginning of the text.

Authors are required to adhere to ethical standards relating to scientific research. The authors guarantee that the manuscript does not contain unsubstantiated or unlawful claims and that it does not infringe the rights of others. Plagiarism, where someone assumes another's ideas, words, or other creative expression as one's own, is a clear violation of scientific and publishing ethics. Plagiarism may also involve a violation of copyright law, which is punishable by legal action. Any manuscript which shows obvious signs of plagiarism will be automatically rejected and author(s) will permanently be forbidden to publish in the journal. The publisher will have no liability in the event of issuance of any claims for damages.
